PUBLIC HEARINGS:

1. **PUBLIC HEARING TO RECEIVE PUBLIC COMMENT ON AMENDMENTS TO THE CDBG (COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT) ONE-YEAR ACTION PLANS FOR PROGRAM YEARS 2014/2015, 2015/2016, 2016/2017, AND 2017/2018**

BACKGROUND: Reprogramming unused CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) funds from program years 2014/2015, 2015/2016, 2016/2017, and 2017/2018 was discussed during work session on January 23, 2018. To utilize unspent funds from previous program years and to avoid the risk of accruing more than 1.5 times the current 2017/2018 program year grant funds, there was consensus that CDBG funds should be reprogrammed towards capital improvement projects. The first public hearing will be to receive public comment and begin a 30-day comment period. At the conclusion of the 30-day public comment period, a second public hearing will be held on April 10, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. to consider finalizing the amendments.

RECOMMENDATION: Receive public comment.
