Chair Bush called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Director Shepherd arrived at 6:03 p.m.

<u>DISCUSSION ON THE CLEARFIELD CITY/DAVIS COUNTY FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT GRANT AWARD</u>

Spencer Brimley, Community Development Director, stated the City in conjunction with Davis County had \$50,000 of grant funding available for façade improvements to commercial properties. He indicated Manuel's El Burrito at 1145 South State Street and the strip mall property located at 1580 South State Street had both submitted applications.

Mr. Brimley reviewed the projects proposed by both applicants. He explained staff recommended the award of funding be made to Manuel's El Burrito, since the proposal would have the greatest impact on the State Street corridor and be most beneficial to the community overall. He commented the award of funding would require an agreement and site plan approval. He suggested the site plan go through an administrative process which followed the land use process and provided the documentation necessary for the proposal.

Director Shepherd expressed his opinion the recommended project would be the best use for the funding. Mr. Brimley stated he would work with the applicant to prepare the agreement for funding which could be considered during a policy session on May 14, 2019. He noted the funds would need to be spent by the end of the year or at least allocated to the project so money could be reimbursed for those façade improvements.

Director Phipps commented it was great to help a long term business of the City. Mr. Gallegos, applicant, thanked the Board.

Director Shepherd moved to adjourn at 6:05 p.m., seconded by Director Roper. The motion carried upon the following vote: Voting AYE – Directors Phipps, Roper, Shepherd and Thompson. Voting NO – None. Director Peterson was not present for the vote.
