Character’s with a \* may be played by either a male or female actor.  
Some roles may be double cast.

## Songs for Auditions

Memorize one of these:

- Into the Woods/Opening Part IX #9 end after “into the woods to get the money.”
- Children Will Listen/Curtain Music #38 end after “to learn what to be.”

OR you may audition with one of these songs. You will need to ask for it to be emailed to you:

- Stay With Me (Witch) #28 end after “Stay at home. I am home.”
- It Takes Two (Baker and Baker’s Wife) #25 (Wife ends after “more openhearted than I knew you to be. Baker ends after “who can tell if you do, it takes two.”
- I Know Things Now (Little Red Ridinghood) #16 end after “well, excited and scared.”
- Hello Little Girl (Wolf) #11 end after “take your time.”
- Giants in the Sky (Jack) #20 end after “a big tall terrible giant at the door.”
- Agony (Both Princes) #22 end after “is the only thing out of your reach.”
- On the Steps of the Palace (Cinderella) #29 end after “and I thought: well, he cares.”

## Monologues for Auditions:

*Memorize one of these OR prepare a monologue that is less than 1 minute*

- Listen well, son. Milky-White must be taken to market. She’s given us no milk for a week. We’ve no food nor money, and no choice but to sell her. Fetch the best price you can. Take no less than five pounds. Are you listening to me?
- As is often the way in these tales, in exchange for her youth and beauty, the Witch lost her power over others. As for Cinderella’s Prince, he began his search for the foot to fit the golden slipper. When he came to Cinderella’s house, Cinderella’s stepmother took the slipper into Florinda’s room.
- Rapunzel, Rapunzel. What a strange but beautiful name. And fit for a Prince! Tomorrow, before that horrible Witch arrives, I will stand before her window and ask her to let down her hair to *me*.
