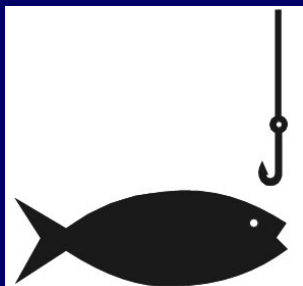


Spring 2017 Fishing Club
